



## Fit-To-Width website export property !!

## POP-UP Menu >> ISSUE 1

1) Small screen (e.g. mobile) // 2) Laptop Screen (e.g. when Browser included bookmark slide) One can not scroll the Pop-UP down to get lower areas visible

As you never know on which display and resolution your customer opens the page -- you better should avoid such conflicts.





## Fit-To-Width website export property!! POP-UP Menu >> ISSUE 2

The webpage itself requires a minimum height, large enough to not impact the automated layoutsystem of sticky objects on **fit-to-width** setup. I do not understand the rules behind it, but I can see the outcome.

- Standard view on small screen
   (e.g.mobile)
   when webpage is a smaller one, even so
   webpage height is generally much bigger
   than the pop-up)
- 2) Laptop Screen, -- the scrambled Pop-up is continue to mixed up even so webpage height is generally much bigger than the pop-up)

## Workaround:

I guess 90% of webpages do not run into this conflict, due to their height. But Impressum or landing page are low in height and this would end up in the described issue.

So in this case, extend the webpage height even so it might be some "lost" spaces.
